Historical Note

The St. Bonifatius Verein held its first meeting on March 10, 1878, and its last meeting on May 11, 1924. This St. Francis Seminary student organization's purpose was to study German drama.

Preceded by the German Drama Association (1875-1877).

Scope and Content

Collection contains records of the St. Bonifatius Verein (St. Boniface Society) from its first meeting on March 10, 1878 to its last meeting in May 1924. Records include collections of outstanding presentations, minutes, programs, records of books, and a treasurer's record. All of the materials in the collection are in German with the exception of research notes, written in English, taken from the minute books.
