Historical Note
Founded on May 16, 1912 the St. Philip Neri Mission Society's purpose was to aid missions at home and abroad, and help foster an active missionary spirit in the students of the seminary.

In the 1966-1967 scholastic year the St. Philip Neri Mission Society became the St. Francis Seminary Mission Board. This new organization was disbanded in mid-April 1968 when board members declared that the new Apostolic Activities program at the seminary would serve the needs previously met by these mission societies.

Scope and Contents
Constitution and by-laws, correspondence, membership information, cash journal, financial reports, minutes, and programs of this St. Francis Seminary student organization.
