Historical Note

This St. Francis Seminary student organization was founded on November 14, 1863. John T. Durward served as president of this organization after John Casey, a senior student, left the seminary at the end of the school year in 1866. St. Joseph's Lyceum ceased to exist after Durward's withdrawal.
