Historical Note
German students at St. Francis Seminary organized this half literary, half social society in the early 1880s. These students gave speeches in German and published a monthly Stimmen aus dem Tartarus. Like the student clubs in German universities, Die Republik imposed on its candidates the name of some leader in art, science, or politics.

Scope and Content
One bound volume, in German, containing a list of members, minutes, and some financial information.
