**Historical Note**  
This student society was formed in 1935. Its aim was to promote Latin culture and Latin speech. At its meetings students delivered papers in Latin and criticized in Latin. Students also printed a weekly Latin essay in the Missionite, a student publication of the Classical Department. All students of the Classical Department were eligible to become members of the Pope Leo XIII Latin Society.
