Scope and Content
This collection contains two volumes of St. Francis Seminary annals. The first volume runs from 1856-1939 and is in Latin. A history of the seminary is found at the front of the volume. The back of the volume has lists of professors, ordinations, and deceased alumni. The second volume runs from 1939-1970 and is in English.
