Historical Note
The Societe St. Jean Baptiste was organized in February 1904. The society's meeting exercises consisted of essays, declamations, informal discussions, and reading of classics, giving members an invaluable opportunity to gain proficiency and fluency in the use of the French language.

Scope and Content
Records from this St. Francis Seminary student organization consist of a minute book (1904-1909, 1932-1935), and a list of rules (1906). Materials in the collection are in French.
