Administrative Note

The Confraternity of Christian Doctrine program is responsible for the catechetical and religious instruction of public school and other students. The Archdiocese of Milwaukee began participating in this program in 1937, resulting in the foundation of the Newman Club.

Scope and Content *a brief description of the types of materials in the collection.*

This collection contains a mostly complete run of the Newman Club Bulletin newsletter from February 9, 1956 (volume XIX, issue 17) to November 20, 1958 (volume XXII, issue 7). Missing issues within this range are volume XX, issues 1 through 4, 7, 11, and 12; volume XXI, issue 22; and volume XXII, issues 1 through 3. A typical issue consists of one double-sided typewritten page featuring stories with moral lessons, thoughtful and humorous sayings, a Saint or Feast of the Week, and music recommendations. The Bulletin was published 30 times per year, roughly weekly between September and May.
