Scope and Content *a brief description of the types of materials in the collection.*

The majority of this collection is “materials produced” by the Office of Religious Education and is arranged chronologically. The records include correspondence, meeting minutes, and fliers; these have been kept in their original order. Also included are copies of the Tell-Spot newsletter. These copies are boxed separately from the original accession and include flier inserts that were not included in the original collection.
