Scope and Content *a brief description of the types of materials in the collection.*

This collection contains meeting minutes of the Interfaith Committee on the Family (1990-1996) as well as a complete run of the journal (2 copies), from 1982-1996.

Historical Note

Seasons was published by the Inter-Faith Committee on the Family which originally included representatives of the American Lutheran Church, the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) in Illinois and Wisconsin, the Milwaukee Diocese of the Episcopal Church, the Wisconsin and Upper Michigan Synod of the Lutheran Church in America, the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Milwaukee, the Wisconsin Conference of the United Church of Christ, the Methodist Church, the United Presbyterian Church, Presbytery of Milwaukee, the Wisconsin Council of Rabbis, and the Milwaukee Jewish Federation. It was published to create a forum where people from different traditions and theological backgrounds could discuss family issues. It was published quarterly from 1982-1992 until it was reduced to a single yearly publication.
