Historical Note

In 1999, Archbishop Rembert Weakland began sending a quarterly newsletter entitled *Spiritual Times* to Catholic households in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. The newsletters were to be “a reminder of how important it is to keep a spiritual focus in our lives” and contained articles focused on spirituality. Upon his appointment in 2002, Archbishop Timothy Dolan assumed leadership of the publication and renamed it *To Live is Christ*. The newsletters continued to be published until 2005.
