Historical Note

The Salesius Verein or the Salesian Society was started in 1853 to organize lay support for the seminary and was incorporated in 1854. From 1853-1857 priests and parishioners from German parishes visited by Dr. Salzmann contributed an average of \$1.00 yearly.

Scope and Content Note

This collection contains ledgers that recorded the donations and subscriptions of the Seminary Salesius Verein from the 1850's. The collections came from individuals from Wisconsin and other Midwestern states.
