Biographical Note

Archbishop Otto Zardetti was a former St. Francis Seminary faculty member (1881-1887), Bishop of St. Cloud, MN (consecrated Oct. 20, 1889), and Archbishop of Bucharest (appointed in early 1894).

Scope and Content *a brief description of the types of materials in the collection.*

This collection contains a diary (1869-1870) and publications (1871-1895) of Otto Zardetti. Addresses and circular letters are included in the collection. The majority of the materials are in German; several publications have been translated into English.
