Scope and Content *a brief description of the types of materials in the collection.*

Collection from a monsignor and former pastor for more than forty years at St. Anthony, Kenosha. Box 1 contains biographical information; church announcements (1930-1932) when he served as pastor at Holy Trinity, Racine and at St. Anthony; correspondence (1930-1985); documents (1917-1965); a folder of family information; funeral materials (1987); silver jubilee materials (1954); and a miscellaneous folder. Boxes 2 and 3 contain liturgical desk calendars (1942-1984). Box 4 contains stipend books (1938-1982) and a St. Joseph's award plaque (1976).
