Scope and Content *a brief description of the types of materials in the collection.*

The collection contains records of a Catholic men's fellowship and service organization affiliated with the Basilica of St. Josaphat. The Holy Name Society at the Basilica was founded in 1926 to encourage members to attend Mass together and to sponsor fund-raising, service, and social events. The collection consists primarily of minutes (1926-1943) and rosters (1962-1965)
