Historical Note

Papal Volunteers for Latin America (PAVLA) was a social ministry organization formed in 1960 under the Pontifical Commission for Latin America. By the time the organization closed in 1971, Papal volunteers had been sent to Peru, the British Honduras, Brazil, Paraguay, Costa Rica, and Jamaica. The branch of the organization from the Archdiocese of Milwaukee sent out its first missionaries to Brazil in 1963. Because PAVLA sought to encourage development in Latin American countries, volunteers needed to know some practical skill, like education, health care, or construction, in addition to theology. After being sponsored by their local parishes, volunteers committed to a three year stay in their chosen country as well as an additional training period prior to leaving. Once they arrived, the volunteers built stoves, latrines, and general purpose buildings or provided health care and education. Rather than direct mission work, the volunteers were to exert Christian influence as they worked. By 1966, the Archdiocese had enough parishioners to build a church in Asuncion, Paraguay and send a second priest to assist the lay volunteers.

Scope and Content Note *a brief description of the types of materials in the collection.*

While this was a national organization, the records of this collection primarily reflect the involvement of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. This collection contains correspondence between Fr. Leo Seramur, Fr. Russell Tikalsky, and the Archdiocesan parishes regarding the formation of PAVLA and the donations that supported the volunteers as well as training material and information about the volunteers. It includes many photographs of Paraguay, Costa Rica, and Jamaica, as well as newspaper clippings about PAVLA. Much of the information centers on the SS. Peter and Paul parish in Asuncion, Paraguay, the Archdiocese of Milwaukee's foreign mission parish. This collection also includes a short film made by Marquette University in the 1966 using footage from Asuncion Paraguay. The film was made to educate the greater Milwaukee area about the people of Paraguay and the work of the Archdiocese priest who served there.
