Historical Note

Holy Redeemer parish was founded on May 12, 1897, with a small steering committee in the village of North Milwaukee. The land chosen for the site of the new parish was surrounded with farmland, marshes, and woods. Fr. Fischer came on his bicycle from St. Boniface parish every other Sunday to celebrate Mass and other sacraments. A rectory was eventually built in 1907. During the Depression years Fr. Nellen took some of his parishioner's mortgages out of the parish to help pay them off. Throughout this period the parish was famous for their chicken dinners. By 1940 membership in the parish was over 5,000, and a new church was completed in 1958.

The parish school opened in 1922 with sixteen children. The School Sisters of St. Francis came to teach, even though Fr. Skolaski admitted that the parish could not afford to pay the teachers. As the size of the parish ballooned exponentially, so did the school, and by the end of the 1930s enrollment was over 600 students, and by 1953 enrollment was over 1,500. A ninth grade was added in 1942.

By the 1970s many parishioners began moving out of the northside, and as a result the parish began to shrink in size. In 1976 the parish began offering bingo twice a month to help support the school. In June of 1987, after a good deal of research into consolidating with other parish schools in the area, the Parish Council voted to close the school.

In an unprecedented move, after 17 years of dialog, Holy Redeemer and Mount Tabor, a United Church of Christ congregation signed a pledge to work together for social justice and the common good, and for the removal of any obstacle to the ecumenical spirit. By 1990 the number of parishioners was down to 500. In 1992 Holy Redeemer merged with St. Nicholas and St. Albert to form Blessed Trinity Parish. In 2011 Blessed Trinity parish merged with St. Catherine parish on 51st and Center, Milwaukee.

Scope and Content *a brief description of the types of materials in the collection.*

Holy Redeemer Church, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, was a Roman Catholic church founded in 1897.

Extensive series within the collection include: various Catholic War Veterans material from 1946-1962, Directors Meeting Minutes from 1897-1930, Holy Name Society Meeting Minutes from 1953-1969,

Parish council Meetings Minutes from 1970-1989, many photographs, and Sunday Bulletins from 1935-1974 and 1981-1990. Holy Redeemer Church merged into Blessed Trinity Church, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, in 1991. Accession #10 11 08b in boxes 32-47 consist primarily of student transcript files, school personnel files, and various reports.
