Access
Open/unrestricted except for legal correspondence, financial statements, marriage records, and teacher personnel records.

Historical Note
In 1913, Archbishop Messmer requested Fr. George Meyer organize a parish “beyond the northern reaches of the city.” Land was purchased in what used to be a large potato and cabbage patch on what is now 11th and Capital. This property was purchased specifically at the highest elevation on the northern edge of the city. At the time there were no sidewalks, sewers, or streets. A small wooden chapel with a seating capacity of 130 was soon completed, and in 1916 a more permanent church was built in the Tudor Gothic style. The government worried the structure was being built too rapidly and suspected it of being a German stronghold. The army was sent in, but of course no armaments were found.

The 1920s proved to be a boom for the parish as houses sprung up in the neighborhood. In 1925, another new combination church and hall was built, and an addition to the school was needed by 1931. For a short time (1933-1934) St. Nicholas parish was a mission parish of Holy Angels. As the demographics of the neighborhood began to change in the 1960s and 1970s the parish became more involved with Milwaukee Inner City Congregations Allied for Hope, Crossroads Interfaith Program for the Elderly, St. Vincent de Paul Society, Emergency Food Pantry Network, and sponsored the Central City Catholic School System. By 1991, the parish was about 60% black and 40% white. Holy Angels is considered the first Catholic Church in the US to have gospel music and a gospel choir providing worship to a largely Black congregation.

Holy Angels closed in 1994. Parishioners of the former St. Agnes, St. Anne, Holy Angels, St. John de Nepomuc, and St. Thomas Aquinas tended to join the new All Saints parish, which was created on November 1, 1994.

Scope and Content *a brief description of the types of materials in the collection.*
Holy Angels Church, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, was founded in 1914. The collection includes bulletins from 1943-1993, correspondence from 1973-1993, parish council materials from 1974-1994, and a large number of photographs. Holy Angels Church merged into All Saints Church, Milwaukee, in 1993.
