Biographical Note

Fr. Richard Storch was born in Milwaukee, Wisconsin on February 17, 1919. He attended St. Francis de Sales Seminary for high school. In 1940 he entered the Pallottines, he was ordained to the priesthood on September 29, 1945, at the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist in Milwaukee by Archbishop Moses Kiley. He was first assigned to the House of Studies in Washington, D.C., then appointed treasurer of Pallottines College in Milwaukee in 1947. He briefly moved to St. Joseph's parish in Brockt, North Dakota to serve three years there as a pastor. Then he was transferred back to Milwaukee and appointed associate pastor of St. Anthony of Padua. In 1965, he was assigned to Pius XI High School, in 1984, he was transferred to the St. Vincent Pallotti Retreat Center and appointed treasurer. He moved to Milwaukee in 1990 and was a member of the Pallotti House community until his death from cancer on February 9, 1999.
