Biographical Note

Leon Joseph Schneider (1927-2002) entered St. Francis Seminary in 1945 and was ordained to the priesthood on May 30, 1953 at the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist in Milwaukee. On June 12, 1953 he began his ministry as an assistant at Holy Angels Parish in Milwaukee. On June 26, 1956 he began serving at St. Catherine High School in Racine, Wisconsin, as an assistant and was named principal on August 3, 1971. Father Schneider became administrator of St. Mary by the Lake Parish on June 25, 1991, where he served until his retirement on February 29, 2000.

Scope and Content *a brief description of the types of materials in the collection.*

This is a collection of various materials pertaining to the life of Father Schneider. It contains photographs (both loose and in photo album), his birth registration card, a 1975 Milwaukee Public Library card, and two small notebooks detailing his travels in 1955 and 1960.
