Part of the collection of Eugene L. Braun (1925-2009) from his time in the Knights of Columbus. He held the rank of fourth decree knight, was a former Grand Knight, and held many positions throughout his time in the order. The collection was donated by his daughter Mary Ellen Feffer (Braun).

Scope and Content Note

This collection of Knights of Columbus memorabilia contains: formal tuxedo, tie, cape, gloves, sashes, sword and sheath, various medals representing positions held in the organization, lapel pins, news clippings of KoC events, certificates of promotions in the order, and certificates of appreciation of service.
