**Biographical Note**

Rev. Herbert J. Wagner was a priest of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. He was born in Burlington on July 1, 1904. He entered St. Francis de Sales Seminary in 1921 and was ordained at St. John's Cathedral on June 10, 1933 by Archbishop Samuel Stritch. Rev. Wagner retired from active ministry in 1968, and died on August 24, 1974.

**Scope and Content** *a brief description of the types of materials in the collection.*

This collection contains one photograph album from Rev. Wagner's time as a student at St. Francis de Sales Seminary. The photograph album is dated 1922, and while it contains a few family photographs it primarily documents his time as a student at the Seminary.
